<u>Client</u> – Residential.

<u>Type of wall constructed</u> – Random Sandstone Boulders.

Brief description of work completed.

After the builder had cut the block for the house pad Australian Retaining Walls were called in for an appraisal and advice on what would be the most suitable wall for the site. Australian Retaining walls then advised the client that a Random Sandstone Boulder wall

with carved sandstone steps would be the most suitable for this site.

Working from the building plans the first step for a Random Sandstone Boulder wall is to mark and peg out the site and set up some string lines.

Then the heavy machinery is brought in! After a small amount of excavation Australian Retaining walls are ready to start construction of another Random Sandstone Boulder wall.

In order to comply with council regulations Australian Retaining walls created three tiers of Random Sandstone Boulder walls on this project, each wall kept under 1metre and 1.5metre apart avoiding substantial costs for permits and planning for our client.
